# SPEAKER PRESENTATION

## “Mary Clare Barker: “Sacred Side of Jazz”



**Mary Clare Barker** holds a Bachelor of Music degree in Music Education from Western Michigan University and a Master of Music degree in piano performance and accompanying from Northwestern University. She lives in Chicago and is an active teacher, soloist, accompanist, and lecturer.

After speaking on numerous occasions on women classical and jazz composers to various academic audiences (twice at the ISMTA conferences), Ms. Barker has recently explored the connections between the faith lives of noted jazz composers and the effects their faith had on their compositions. Last November she presented this lecture to the Northwest Suburban MTA and will soon present this lecture this year to North Shore MTA.

Currently, Mary Clare performs at jazz clubs throughout Chicago and is a music minister at St. Gertrude Catholic parish in Chicago’s Edgewater neighborhood.

**Michelle Brooks** holds a degree in Music with a concentration in Voice and Sacred Music from Hope Bible Institute and Seminary in Indiana. Currently she teaches music at Northside Catholic Academy in Chicago- Preschool-5th grade. She has taught general music classes for 4 years.

Ms. Brooks performs classical and sacred music throughout the Chicago area. She also gives private/group voice and piano lessons and is an instructor for vocal workshops and gospel choirs.

On the weekends, Michelle is the Children’s music director at Sword of the Lord Ministries International Church in the south suburbs.
